Breaking News: Important Announcement re the Re-instatement of the meeting of the 4th African Assembly 2025, Entebbe, Uganda.

Following a meeting on the 20th August of the Vice Presidents of the Francophone, West African, East African, and Southern and Central African Divisions of the International Academy of Pathology, together with the President of the British Division of the IAP, the Immediate Past President of the IAP and the international convenors of the academic programme, the following decisions have been made and are being implemented:

- 1. The meeting of the 4th African Assembly will take place from 8th 9th October 2025 in Entebbe, Uganda at the Admas Grand Hotel (please note amended dates).
- 2. The African Assembly event will be a hybrid event with in-person or virtual attendance.
- 3. A website giving further details will be active next week.
- 4. The registration fees are: in-person US\$100 for pathologists and US\$50 for trainees; virtual attendance US\$50. A registration link will be provided on the website.
- 5. The meeting will focus on Updates in Haematopathology, Infectious Disease and One Health. Updates on further topics will be on the website when available.
